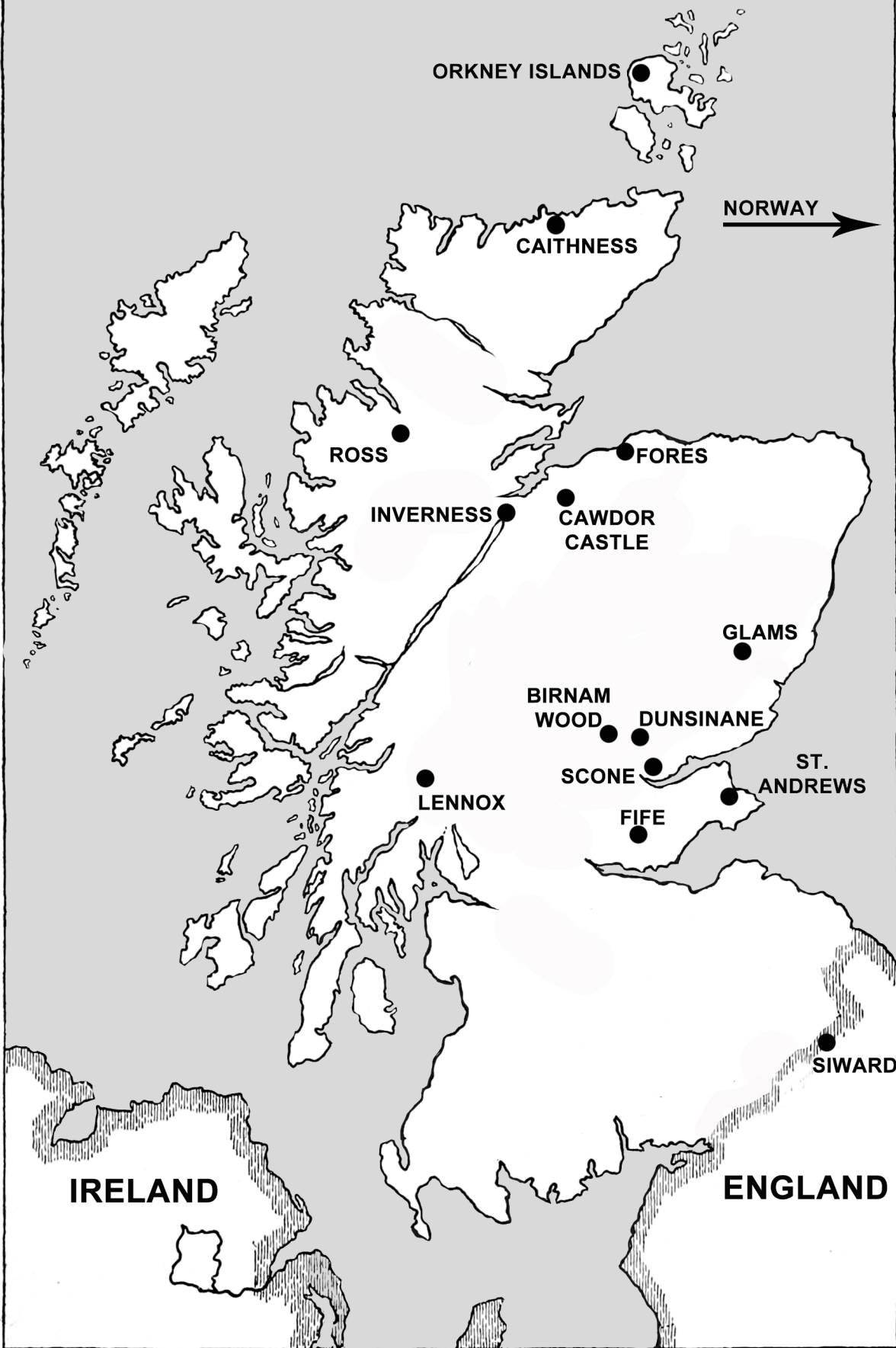


MACBETH'S SCOTLAND



INVERNESS
Macbeth's castle. He kills Duncan here.

GLAMS CASTLE -
In the play it serves as Macbeth's Castle. In reality, Glams was built in the 14th century. Moray was the area where Macbeth's castle was located.

SCONE
This was the traditional place where Scottish kings were crowned.

FORRES
This is where King Duncan had his castle.

NORWAY
Viking raids had disrupted Scotland for centuries ending around 1200. Macbeth opens with a battle against the Irish and Hebridians, followed by an invasion by Norway and Norse settlers from the Orkney Islands.

SIWARD
This area of England is where Macbeth's disaffected troops gathered before they marched to Dunsinane to replace Macbeth with Malcom.

FIFE
Macduff's home. He leaves for England to join Malcom, and Murderers kill his family.
